THE TRAGEDY

In 2006 I noticed that my three-year-old daughter, Shayla, had trouble walking. Though the pediatrician said she was just delayed in her development, my concern drove me to take her to a neurologist. After numerous tests, this doctor pronounced devastating news: my precious little princess had an extremely rare genetic disease called Vanishing White Brain Matter, a form of leukodystrophy. There was no treatment, no medication, no cure...no hope.

Unwilling to accept this morbid fate, I promised little Shayla that we would beat this thing...with God's help. But I knew I didn't deserve any special attention from the Almighty—certainly not a miracle of this magnitude. This was all my fault. My beautiful daughter was bearing the punishment for my years of sin, crime, and depravity.

THE TRANSFORMATION

In this book, two dramatic stories are told in parallel. Woven alongside the journey dealing with Shaylo's disease, and my quest for divine healing for her, is an account of my own childhood and adolescence—beginning with the murder of my parents when I was five years old, and continuing through years of rebellion and hatred as I lashed out at loved ones, life, and God.

As a frightened parent taken far beyond my ability to handle my circumstances, I begged God for my daughter's physical healing. As He traveled this difficult path with me, He brought healing to my own heart and soul, blessings beyond measure, and forgiveness for every sin I had ever committed. He assured me, in numerous ways, that Shayla's disease was not my fault. On the contrary, it was actually part of His divine plan, which was beyond human comprehension.



THE TRIUMPH

Against all human odds, Shayla has lived far beyond her projected lifespan. And not just survived—she touches the lives of everyone she meets with her love, joy, and compassion. In spite of her ongoing physical difficulties, this eight-year-old prays for the needs of others, sees the best in all people, and helps them to see it in themselves. As her father and partner in this struggle, I have learned that God's ways, though impossible for us mortal beings to understand, are truly best. My daughter and I are both exactly where the wants us to be.
